



Samhati: An Overview


- → Founded in 1984: 40+ years in operation, longest running organization of Bangladeshi women in the US

- ◆ Samhati is a non-political organization and our projects are continuing despite political instability in Bangladesh






Our Regional Programs Continue to Thrive









LAKSMICHAP



- Multi-faceted program started in 2011 in Laksmichap Union, a diverse community in Rangpur (Northern Bangladesh)
- The project is run by local leaderships and a dedicated retired volunteer coordinator
- Continue to expand the program including a new soccer/football club for girls

















NATORE





- ◆ Strong program making positive change to these communities in Northern Bangladesh, in its 18th year!
- → Hatiandah is a union of 8 villages in Northern Bangladesh, and our work continues to bring considerable positive change
- Focus on education, literacy, scholarships, and small business training











The computer training classes are very popular, with 46 young people graduating from the program this past year. Currently, we have 18 girls and 4 boys enrolled.





KATAKHALI





- → Holistic eco-empowerment project since 2000 in this remote coastal area in Patuakhali district, as well as Modhukhali Village
- → Focus on adult literacy, leadership building, health and family planning
- **→** Tremendous positive impact within this community









We also focus on skills related to their vulnerability to climate change. For example, plantings that will help limit erosion, etc.












Our preschools in both Katakhali & Modhukhali are thriving with 43 younger children enrolled

Our Goal: *\$100,000*

\$75 = one-year scholarship to keep a middle/ high school child in school

\$100 = adult literacy or vocational classes

\$125 = Bicycle and helmet

\$250 = 3 months of college costs for a low income young woman

\$500 = our health clinic in Katakhali village for one month, providing care for the entire island

\$1,000 = a female nursing or college student for a whole year
